Oakhill MX Park in Decatur, Texas was the site of the Texas Off-road Racing Organization's Round 2 action. This is the second year TORO has co-sanctioned with WORCS to bring this national event to North Texas and it was once again well received by the TORO membership. It is not too often the locals get to be on the track at the same time as such national names as Nathan Woods and Juha Salminen.

TORO Series Director, Shawn Goolsby said, "As anyone who has co-sanctioned knows, there are more than just a few obstacles to overcome to make a successful event. Fortunately, TORO and WORCS have a first rate staff and racers so it was not a problem. It appears that the customers were satisfied, and that's what it's all about. I'm glad to have been able to play a part in making 800 plus racers happy."

The track was not the normal seven-plus miles of off-road racing that TORO members are used to. It was a five mile mixture of motocross and off-road with a log jump rock element area, which is always a spectator favorite. Saturday morning got off to a start with the Pee Wee 65 A, B and Mini 85cc C class where JD Reed, Blake Matthews and Trevor Buck respectively each took their second win of the season.

The 250 and 200 A and B classes were next up on Saturday where Beau Otto took first for the second time this season in the 250 A class. Brad Mayo (250B), Taylor Thomas (200A) and Matt Sparks (200B) all got their first wins of the season.

AA action saw Josh Young, first place Pro from the South Texas Off-road Motorcyclists (STORM) club hold on for his first win of the season and the overall lead in the series. 20 year old TJ Cycles KTM, Dunlop and MSR sponsored Young said, "I was really hoping for the holeshot, but when that didn't happen I just started working my way through the pack. I'm very fortunate to have finished in first this race. I got by [Caleb] Ramsay on the last lap and figured I was in second. I only found out later that TORO Pro, Matt Crouch, had bike trouble and wasn't in front of me."

Yamaha, MSR, and ScottUSA-sponsored, Matt Crouch broke his chain near the pits and was able to get it fixed in time to squeak out a ninth place finish moving him behind Ramsay and in third for the series overall.

On a solemn note, TORO lost a member Saturday when Gary Ratliff passed away from what appears to be natural causes. In honor of Gary, the number 940 (+60 class) will be permanently retired at TORO.
