The Stone Creek Trail Riding Park in Bells, Texas was the site of Texas Off-road Racing Organization's third round of action. Promoter, Tom Robinson, went to work creating an almost entirely new thirteen mile course for all to enjoy. Even people who frequent this riding park had a hard time recognizing the terrain and trail Robinson pulled together for the event and his extra effort was praised by those in attendance.

In AA action, Mark Weeks got back on track with a huge win. "Brian Storrie got the holeshot and I raced with him for a couple miles before taking the lead, said G&S Suzuki/Scott/Michelin-sponsored Weeks. "I kept pushing really hard to try to build as big of a lead as I could. I never heard anyone again. The only trouble I had was on the third lap when I went down pretty hard. I broke my throttle housing and had to pull the cable to work the throttle to the finish. I ended up with a chipped bone in my wrist."

"I've had some bad luck lately and let it drag me down. People started to doubt me and my ability so I started working really hard again to show them I can still compete. This was a big confidence builder for me... I am pretty excited about this win!"

The Open A class saw Cody Beck take his first win of the TORO season. "I didn't really get a good start. I flooded my bike and was about 15 seconds behind everyone, said Honda West/SMS Racing/Thor-sponsored Beck. "I rode really aggressive and passed everyone by about mile four. Cooper Bailey and I battled it out for the next couple laps, but I got time on him when he pitted." Beck chuckled, "I paced myself in the third lap because I really didn't think I was going to win, but when I was still in the lead on the fourth lap, I picked it up again!"

The win moved 16 year-old Beck in third place behind Open A veterans David Lucas, Jr. and Cecil Parker in the season standings.

Christopher Groening and Chris Elwood picked up their first wins in the Open B and C classes while Beau Otto continued to dominate the 250A class with his third straight victory. 250 B and C classes had Luke Humphries and Gabe McClendon winning for the first time this season as well as Tyler Schexnaider, Danny Cooksey and Chase Robinson in the 200 A, B and C classes.

In Ladies action, Amber Terry picked up her first win in the C class, which moved her to second place in the standings while Susette Dupuis captured her first victory in the +30 Woman C class.

In Saturday's Pee Wee action Cole Neal and Nathan Wood saw their first wins of the TORO season in the 50cc A and B classes.
