### **Demuth Pays TORO a Visit!**

It was off to Bowie, Texas this week for Texas Off-road Racing Organization's third round of action. Bowie MX did a stellar job of combining their nicely manicured motorcross track with surrounding woods, rock-laden hills, tight tree sections, and an extreme section near camp that fast became the fan favorite.

Arenacross Champion 27-year-old Josh Demuth showed up to try his hand at TORO for the first time. Demuth commented, "I'm getting older and would like to try some off-road events like this, WORCS, and maybe some GNCCs."

Demuth got a fairly bad start from dead-engine off the line, but screamed past the competition in no time to make his way to the front of the pack where he would remain for the duration of the race.

18-year-old SMS Racing/Gas Gas/MSR/ScottUSA-sponsored Caleb Ramsay was Demuth's closest competitor all day coming within seconds of him on a few of the laps.

"After I was VERY quickly passed by Demuth off the start, I knew I had better get by some guys and make up time quick or I would never see him again," Ramsay said. "I passed Beau Otto having problems and followed Mark Weeks for a while until I got by him near the end of the first lap. At the beginning of the second lap I came up on Cooper Bailey – he took a fall coming out of the extreme section, it looked like a pretty bad one, and I got by him. I saw Demuth after he made a pit for gas, but I could never pull close – my arms started pumping up trying to push."

Two KTM riders out of Lubbock, 27-year-old Cycle Town South-sponsored Don Hogan and 17-year-old Cycle Shack of Lubbock-sponsored Cameron Kirkpatrick took third and fourth respectively, while Bryan Vaughan rounded out the top five. Family Powersports/J 3:16 Racing-sponsored Bailey is leading the AA class, where only ten points separate fifth from first!

With three rounds of action completed, the Griner Award honoring the top TORO A rider is up for grabs. The front runners for the coveted award are David Lucas, Jr. (Heavy A), Cecil Parker (+30A), Ray Jennings (+40A) and Jeff Kring (+50A) – all with three wins each.

Will Dinwiddie (Heavy B), Bryan Debrick (Heavy C), Braydon Kramer (Lite C) and Mike Cross (+35C) all scored their first victory of the season. In Ladies action it was Hannah Otto (Ladies B), Haley Neal (Ladies C) and Elena White (Ladies +30B) taking home their first gold medals of the series.

Mini standout, Brandon Glenn, racked up his third win of the season in the expert class while John Short gave up a win to Michael Giboney in the Mini B class, but still maintains a fairly sizable lead on his class for the season. It was Matt Ryan, Dillon Green and Tyler Chidester taking top three in the Mini C class with Ryan assuming the first place position in the series, Chidester five points back and Green twelve points off the lead.

Saturday's Pee Wee action saw Cole Neal (PW50A) and Ryan McKinney (PW65A) both take another win towards their perfect seasons in their respective expert classes, while Colton Hansen (PW50B) and Blake Breton (PW65B) both brought home their first win to date.
