

TORO – Texas Off-road Racing Organization  
Round 4 – Stone Creek Park – Bells, Texas  
**Kirkpatrick - Two for Two in TORO!**

Bells, Texas – just north of the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex – played host to the Texas Off-road Racing Organization's fourth round of action. Stone Creek Park is hard-packed and slick when it is dry and can be like riding on ice when it is too wet. The 446 racers were treated to just enough moisture to make the track tacky all weekend long; perfect racing conditions with temperatures in the 50's and the sun shining!

Sixteen-year-old Family Powersports of McKinney/Precision Motorcycle Products/Tucker Rocky-sponsored Cooper Bailey said, "I got an awesome start and passed Mark Weeks within the second corner to take over first. I led the entire first lap, but I could see Cole Kirkpatrick gaining on me."

KTM/Cycle Shack of Lubbock/Moose Racing/Enduro Engineering-sponsored Cole Kirkpatrick, fresh off his Gold medal performance at the ISDE said, "I got a poor start and worked my way up through the pack because I knew that Cooper was putting time on us. About halfway through the first lap I was able to get into second and on his back tire before we went through the scoring area. Cooper was riding awesome and I was having a blast racing with him. I made the pass midway through the second lap, but had to pit for gas so Cooper got back by. I chased him down again and was able to hold my lead until the finish."

Bailey finished just nine seconds behind Kirkpatrick and is still leading the series. Beau Otto finished third, Cody Beck took fourth and Cameron Ishmael rounded out the top five.

Seventeen-year-old Beck was thrilled with his finish and his first share of the pro purse.

"In the races leading up to Bells I always had felt fast, but had not been able to put a race together," said the RFC Ministries/SMS Racing/Moose Racing-sponsored Beck. "I've been riding and training a lot since moving to the AA class and knew it would eventually pay off. The competition has been pretty stiff because for the most part – everyone is close to the same speed."

"After I caught and passed Cameron Ishmael, I slowed my pace. I knew I had a top five finish I've been wanting and I didn't want to throw it away," Beck said. "Cole and Cooper were already so far ahead that there was no way I could catch them. Beau Otto caught me towards the middle of the fourth lap and passed me just after the white flag. I just rode out that last lap with satisfaction. I finally got top five!"

With three rounds of racing remaining in the series, the coveted Griner Award honoring the top TORO A rider is still up for grabs. Heavy A rider David Lucas, Jr., Over 30 A rider Cecil Parker and Over 40 A rider Ray Jennings remain in the running to claim the custom painted helmet at the end of the series!

In other racing Sunday, Ladies A rider Ashley Crouch and Ladies B rider Jordon Milbauer both took home their first win of the series.
